Class: Visual Arts-Drawing	Grade Band: 9-12
Teacher: Atilio Pernisco	Lesson: Abstract Composition
Objectives: Students will be able to create a composition using different materials and techniques such as shading from observation, simplify by using graphic techniques and draw an abstraction it by using coloring shapes.	Materials: Regular graphite pencil, black marker and color pencils.
Process: 1-Place the paper horizontally and divide it by 3 equal spaces. 2- In the first division draw an object such as your pair of scissors or anything you find interesting to draw by using shading techniques with graphite pencil. This one process should be the more realistic one of the three divisions. 3- The next drawing will be done by making a simpler black and white graphic of the same pair of scissors. This approach is using black marker to fill the spaces. Try making the drawing a little bigger maybe a close up of the scissors. Only black and white. Make sure you are tracing and filling each shape at a time and leave the white space of the paper to be your white. 4- The last area should be done with color pencils. The drawing should be drawn lightly using geometrical shapes or intersecting shapes inspired by the pair of scissors. This last image is purely abstract. 5- At the end you should have experienced going from a traditional to more abstract and colorful work. Have lots of fun!	
Vocabulary: Abstract: a way to make it simpler.
