**Grade Band:** K and 1st

**Teacher:** Mrs. Mably

**Lesson:** Writing a Simple Sentence

**Objectives:** Students will write a sentence using SNAP words and details.

**Materials:** Pencil, paper and crayons

**Process:**

If using blank paper, please draw a line to separate half of the paper. You will be using the bottom section for writing words and the top section for drawing a picture.

Step 1: Please think about something you like to do during playtime. You will write the sentence, "I like to play."

These are all SNAP words. Snap words are words that kindergarten and first grade students are expected to know by recognition.

Please remember to leave a finger space in-between your words.

After you write, "I like to play." You may add another sentence with more detail such as, I like to play at the park. I like to play with my friend. We play with legos. " OR move on to the next step.

Step 2. Please draw a picture with a pencil that matches your writing. Please use 5 colors in your picture. EX: Green for grass, Yellow for Sun, Blue for sky or ocean, brown for a tree,, red for a fire truck etc... All colors for Rainbows!

Extension: Please continue writing this sentence for 1 week. If you are ready to move on, you may practice with these two sentences: 1. I like to eat \_\_\_\_\_. 2. I like to go

**Vocabulary:**

SNAP words are high frequency words that students need to know without sounding them out.
