Lesson: Making a Caterpillar

Objectives: Students will recognize shapes around them. Students will make circles, use scissors, and glue.

Materials: Construction paper, or white paper, crayons, glue scissors, a circle to trace.

Process:

1. Using green paper, or white paper colored green trace with a pencil, 5 circles (or more) and cut them out. You can use a lid from the kitchen or a circle to trace. Set aside.
2. Using red construction paper or white paper colored red, trace one circle and cut it out. Set aside.
3. Lay each circle side by side, slightly overlapping. Glue the green circles to resemble a caterpillar body. At the end of the green circles, glue the red circle for the caterpillar's head.
4. Draw two circles out of white paper for eyes. These circles are small circles. Color in the pupil on the circle. Cut these out and glue onto the red circle.
5. Cut out two small yellow rectangles for the antennae. Glue these on the top of the red head.
6. Draw a Smile on the caterpillar!

Vocabulary: 1. Caterpillar: middle life stage of a butterfly, 2. Circle: round shapes, 3. Rectangle: long shapes shorter on one side and long on the other two sides.
