Class: Story Telling

Grade Band: 2-5

Teacher: Musick

Lesson: Write a story

**Objectives:**  
Students will put together various storytelling components to write an original story.

**Materials:**  
White paper  
Lined paper  
Pen or pencil

**Process:**

Today's lesson is putting together a writing piece.

- Start with a blank piece of paper. Fold it in half lengthwise, then fold it into thirds. There should be six boxes. Label the boxes:


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- Students should fill in each box BRIEFLY. Complete sentences are not needed, just rough ideas.
- On the top of the lined paper, have students write the lesson they want the reader to learn from their story. This is the theme. (For example: Friends will always be there when you need them.)
- Finally, they will put all these components together to create a story.
- The focus should be on the story elements (character, plot, setting, catalyst, climax, resolution, and theme) NOT on spelling, punctuation or grammar.
